

Seattle Co-Arts is awarding four monetary scholarships in 2018 to four deserving art students: three general awards for \$1000, \$750, and \$500 respectively, and a fourth, the Sheila Newman Memorial Scholarship, in the amount of \$1000.

Important dates:

**April 1, 2018** deadline to submit application

**May 4, 2018** Committee meets with student applicants to review their art

**May 11, 2018** Inform student applicants whether they will receive an award

**May 22, 2018** SCA May Meeting presentation of the Scholarship awards

Award winners must attend the SCA meeting on May 22, 2018 and bring three samples of their art work

### I. Criteria for Eligible Students:

Eligible students are those currently enrolled in a recognized art school or program with at least one academic year remaining. Samples submitted should include 2-D media in oil, acrylic, watercolor, graphite, colored pencil, collage, encaustic, mixed media, or similar 2-D media.

(Please note that previous \$1000 scholarship winners are not eligible.)

### *Attachment A.*

#### **Student Résumé**

Provide a one-page résumé on your accomplishment as an artist and an art student.

This may include:

1. Classes
2. Workshops
3. Related Employment
4. Participation in Art Events
5. Related Community Service
6. Awards and Scholarships
7. Names of Counselors and Mentors

### *Attachment B.*

#### **Essay on Career Goals**

Write an essay (1 page in length) describing your art career goals. Please also include a paragraph on how this scholarship would affect those goals

### *Attachment C.*

#### **Two Letters of Recommendation**

- Provide a letter of recommendation from an art instructor or advisor relating to art ability, scholarship, and promise.
- Provide a letter of recommendation that includes a character reference

### *Attachment D.*

#### **Examples of Your Art Work**

1. Submit two photo examples of your current art work.
2. Finalists will be required to submit three more examples
3. Examples will be submitted digitally as JPG's; each example should be no smaller than 800 pixels in width and no larger than 1200 pixels in either width or height.
4. Photo file names should be formatted as follows:

Lastname\_Firstname\_Title.jpg
